

Traveling to Sedona? How to Get Here...

* Hwy-179 is designated as an All America Road by the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA). The National Scenic Byways Program recognizes, preserves and enhances selected roads throughout the United States. Hwy-179 is recognized as an All-American Road / National Scenic Byway based its natural, recreational and scenic qualities.

Hwy-179 is currently undergoing road improvements. Visitors may experience minor traffic delays. For updates on road conditions, visit www.scenic179.com or call 800-529-2876. Also when in the vicinity tune into Highway Advisory Radio on AM 1630.

From Phoenix

Total Distance: 119 Miles

Estimated Total Time: 2 hours

Option A: *

- 1: Take I-17 north towards Flagstaff (98 miles)
- 2: Exit at Hwy-179* (exit 298)
- 3: Turn left (west) onto Hwy-179*
- 4: Proceed on Hwy-179* to Sedona (14 miles)

Option B:

- 1: Take I-17 north towards Flagstaff (89 miles)
- 2: Exit at AZ-260 (exit 289)
- 3: Turn left onto AZ-260. Proceed west towards Hwy-89A (16 miles)
- 4: Turn right on Hwy-89A and continue to Sedona (19 miles)

From Las Vegas

Total Distance: 275 Miles

Estimated Total Time: 5 hours

- 1: Take I-515 / US-93 towards Hoover Dam / Arizona (20 miles)
- 2: Continue on US-93 towards Kingman, AZ (6 miles)
- 3: Turn Left onto US-93 / I-40 (78 miles)
- 4: Proceed east on I-40 towards Flagstaff, AZ (145 miles)
- 5: Take I-17 south (exit 195)(3 miles)
- 6: Take Hwy-89A (exit 337)
- 7: Proceed south on Hwy-89A to Sedona (23 miles)

From Los Angeles

Total Distance: 482 Miles

Estimated Total Time: 7 hours, 30 minutes

Option A:

- 1: Take I-10 east to Hwy-101 north
- 2: Take Hwy 101 north to I-17 north
- 3: Follow option A or B from Phoenix

Option B:

- 1: Take I-40 east towards Flagstaff
- 2: Refer to #4 above (from Las Vegas)
